Thank you for the extension for our response; as we are still compiling requested information, I doubt that we can meet the September 23rd, 2009 Response Due date. We do, however, believe that we can provide the remaining information due within the next 90 days.

Please continue to use Mr MacDermott and his address as the official contact address of record; now that he has returned, he has agreed to continue to act as our agent in this matter and will be handling further communications.

The GDVCG has altered and signed its governing document as requested. The other subordinate groups are working (to the best of my knowledge) on making the requested changes in their Articles of Incorporation or Organization. For the requested information parts 2) through 8) – I have attached a response for most of the items. #'s 4 and 5 are still taking some time to complete.

I hope you will take these materials as an earnest attempt on our part to meet the requirements of the IRS, despite the difficulties of moving documents around the country, collecting signatures and of bemused non-lawyers trying to meet government requirements!
