The conversions are being performed by Guy Spiller, of <u>VGO Productions, LLC</u>. who runs an online

business for video transfers called $\underline{\text{AnalogRetentive.com}}.$

Video conversion to digital files cost: \$1.10 per minute The three masquerades will cost no more than

\$1452. These files will be put on a 3T hard drive provided by us (\$150) and shipped back to us (\$50).

We are requesting the Board to amend the 2016 budget by adding \$1452 to "Acquisitions" (5110) to

cover the conversion costs. The amount will come from accrued assets in Archives account 1325. There

is approximately \$5000 available in this account. The cost of the hard drive and shipping will come from

amounts already approved in the 2016 budget.

This is a rare opportunity, and we encourage the board to approve this request.
